Background

On 26/10/2020 an FPC Officer was driving east towards Menzies on the Evanston-Menzies Rd. The vehicle struck a large pothole at 95-100km/h as they approached a crest, bursting the front and back drivers side tyres. The driver was not injured; however, this incident could have been much worse.

The unsafe road surface is located at -29.7373671638805, 120.75750516042902.



Control Measures

- The unsafe road surface has been reported to the Shire of Menzies for urgent repair.
- FPC Officer used recent driver training and experience to avoid swerving and potentially losing control of the vehicle.
