# TITLE: Illegal Dumping of Potentially Hazardous Material

### Background

FPC is significantly exposed to the illegal dumping of multiple types of potentially hazardous materials within our operational sites.

To record and manage where and what is potentially being illegally dumped, FPC Officers are able to record GPS points or polygons on our Field Maps for ArcGIS system.

This information can then be communicated to contractors and others within normal operational start up and handover processes and documentation.

## Actions

#### Contractors –

- should they identify, potential illegally dumped hazardous material, secure and/or identify the hazard site where practicable.
- advise their authorised officer, who will investigate the hazard and record its location, and initiate the management process.

#### FPC Authorised Officers –

- investigate reported potential, illegally dumped hazardous material, and record its location on Field Maps (as a 'Hazard' point or 'Hazardous Area' polygon, labelled as "Asbestos")
- advise FPC management where necessary for further actions required by FPC or the landowner
